Classes 1to 15 – “The Goat Classes/Milking Competitions only/are held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor, the

registered name and number and identification mark being quoted on the entry form. (Also the kidding date for goats in milk). All goats in milk must be kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the date of the show”.

A Rosette for the Best Goat in Show

A Challenge Certificate for the best goat that has borne a kid

A Challenge Certificate for the Best Inspection/Production Goat.

A Breed Challenge Certificate for the Best Goat that has borne a Kid of each of the Following Breeds:-Anglo Nubian, Saanen, Toggenburg, British Alpine, British Guernsey, British Saanen, British Toggenburg and Golden Guernsey.

A Certificate of Merit for the Best British Milker that has borne a kid/ over one year old.

Special Awards –

Day 1 – None this Year

Day 2 – The “Heffer” Challenge Trophy for the Best British Alpine Goat, Goatling Or Kid.

All Milking goats in both Inspection and Milking classes must have kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 Days before the show

Milkers must arrive at the Show Grounds no later than 5.30pm on Thursday 11th July and must be stripped out to the satisfaction of the Stewards by 6.00pm.

Milkers in Inspection Classes must parade before the Judge at 6.30am and again at 10.30am on Friday 12th July and Sat 13th July.

All milking to be carried out under strict supervision of the stewards before 8.00am and again before 6.00pm.

Milkers are not permitted to leave the Show grounds until after 4.30pm milking, and must not receive any milk or milk substitutes. Any medicines can only be administered with the authorisation of the Chief Steward.

Any exhibitor entering a goat as “Registrations applied for” must provide the Registered Number to the Steward before the goat may compete.

NO PREGNANT GOAT MAY BE ADMITTED TO THE SHOW GROUND

In the event of an unforeseen kidding or abortion the goat will be immediately isolated from all other goats. Full details of the goat, exhibitor and the action taken will be reported in writing to The British Goat Society immediately after the show.

All Milkers MUST compete both days young stock may be entered for Saturday only

Straw will be available @ £2.20 per bale please book the no off bales when entering

Penning Arrangements

Penning will be 2 Milker per pen and 2 Goatlings per pen Hurdles will be available for any one that wishes to divide a pen. Exhibitors that have entered stock for both days will be given priority penning.
